

2024 CHALLENGE


Wow! The 2024 challenge was an amazing start to the year!

Congratulations to Jade and Moonstone class on their hugely successful bake sales! Moonstone's £315 is now the total to beat!






SPRING DISCO

A big thank you to everyone who joined us to take part and to the Co-op for the very generous food donations. We are already looking forward to next year!


EGG DECORATING COMPETITION




WELLBEING HUB


A reminder as to what the wellbeing hub is being built for:

Treasurer




